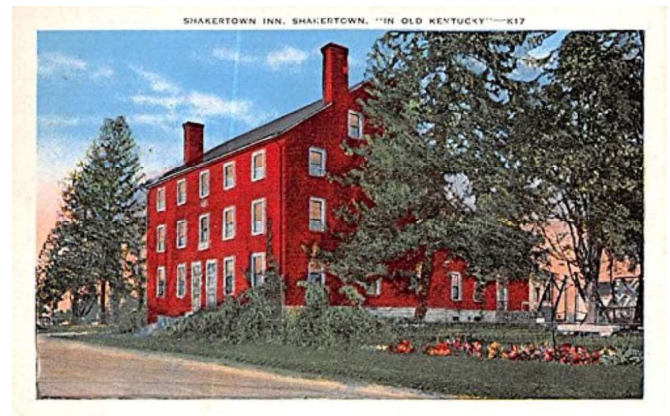
Travel on to Shaker Village for a tour and dinner at the Trustee House and an overnight stay.
