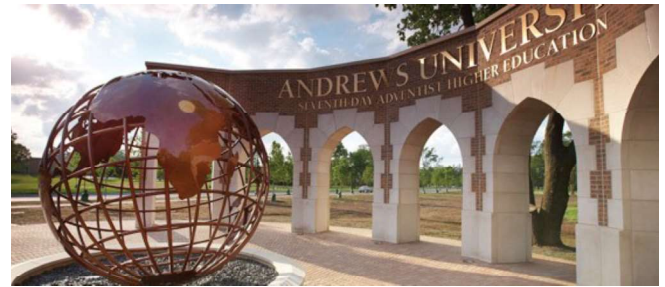


# Historic Treasures in Southwest MI

**Wednesday, September 4, 2019**  
**Day Trip**

- Experience a guided tour of beautiful Andrews University – founded in 1874, set on 1,600 acres on the St. Joseph River in Berrien Springs.
- Learn at the Siegfried H. Horn Museum which houses thousands of artifacts spanning over 5,000 years of history – including Egyptian, Palestinian and Mesopotamian.
- Travel to the Tabor Hill winery for a luncheon (included) along with panoramic views of the vineyards.
- Visit the historic Chapin House in Niles, a three story red brick Queen Anne structure dating back to 1884.
- A stop at the Fort St. Joseph Museum located in the Carriage house of the Chapin Mansion is included.
- On the journey homeward, experience the “Old Rugged Cross Historic Site” built in 1862 in Pokagon where this old hymn was first sung in public.
