

How to Make a Sock Puppet Mascot

MATERIALS:

- Socks in any color or size that will stretch over your wrist and your arm
- Small piece of cardboard
- Hot glue or other adhesive
- Scissors
- Felt (for animal ears, tongue, etc.)
- Googly eyes or buttons for eyes
- Permanent Markers, yarn, ribbon and other small items



MAKE THE SOCK PUPPET MOUTH:

- Turn your sock inside out
- Lay the sock heel side up
- Cut a piece of cardboard (minimum 2" long) and as wide as the toe of your sock as shown in the photo below. If you want the mouth deeper make the cardboard longer.
- Fold the cardboard in half.
- Glue the cardboard around the toe of the sock.
- Once the glue is dry, turn the sock right side out by slipping your hand in the sock and hold the edges of the cardboard as you pull the sock off.
- Position sock with heel of the sock at the top of the head.



Glue the eyes, nose, and tongue if you have one onto your puppet, and any other items to complete your mascot!
