Travel Policies

RESERVATIONS

Payment for one-day trip reservations is due in full at the time of sign-up. The deposit for an extended trip is due at the time of sign-up. Payment may be made in person at the Center or by calling the Trip Office to make arrangements to send the payment by mail. Early registration is encouraged. A waitlist is started when a trip becomes full.

FOR YOUR PROTECTION

All travelers must provide updated emergency contact information and have a release of liability form on file. In addition, any special travel needs, allergies or medical information that is pertinent to travel should be provided and kept up to date with the Travel Office. Travelers are encouraged to carry a list of medications or other pertinent emergency information (if applicable).

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

- Contact the Travel Office to cancel a reservation.
- A traveler may NOT sell their reservation to someone else.
- Depending on the payment schedule to venues, a full refund may not be possible unless the Center can fill the spot.
- Refund policies and penalties vary on extended trips and on the timing of the cancellation.
- A refund may take 2 to 4 weeks to process.
- The Portage Zhang Senior Center reserves the right to cancel a trip if too few people sign up.

Any Center specific and detailed COVID related guidelines regarding travel will be defined and revised as needed.

...As our journey begins, we head toward East Tawas for lunch before stopping at the Lumberman's Monument, 14-foot bronze statue dedicated to the workers of the early logging industry in Michigan located high above the Au Sable River within the Huron-Manistee National Forest. Afterwards we arrive at the Holiday Inn Express in Alpena to check in, before enjoying dinner.

Day two we will make our way over to the Thunder Bay Maritime Museum for a glass-bottom boat ride on Thunder Bay to view some of the 100 shipwrecks! After the boat ride there will be time to tour the museum before spending the rest of the afternoon leisurely exploring local galleries and parks in Alpena.

Day three we travel to 40 Mile Point Lighthouse north of Rogers City. After lunch, we will take in the Old and New Presque Isle Lighthouse Park before heading to dinner at Churchill Point Inn on Hubbard Lake.

Our final day we begin our journey back to Portage with a MYSTERY stop in the Bay City/Saginaw area.
